



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


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






















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What is an Access Mechanism?



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Rights-based Access

Ability to benefit from resources is sanctioned by law, costumes or convention

Structural Mechanism of Access

Ability to benefit form resources is mediated by political-economic constraints

Relational Mechanisms of Access

Ability to benefit form resources is meditated by culture and norms


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Comparing GAANA to Traditional Needs Assessment



GAANA

- Begins with assets and strengths
- Identifies accessibility and power relations
- Focuses on internal capacities

Traditional NA

- Begins with discrepancies and gaps
- Focuses on external solutions
- Focuses on quantifiable solutions
